

## AFFIDAVIT OF SURVIVING SPOUSE FOR PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION


PURSUANT TO NEVADA REVISED STATUTE 361.080

I, the undersigned, hereby affirm that I am a bona fide resident of the State of Nevada (six months minimum or possess a valid Nevada Driver's License or Identification Card), I meet all requirements for the exemption as a surviving spouse under NRS 361.080 and I have not claimed this exemption in any other county in the State of Nevada.

A surviving spouse is not entitled to this exemption in any fiscal year beginning after any remarriage, even if the remarriage is later annulled.

## I wish to apply my exemption for the 2023/2024 fiscal year of 1,670 in assessed value to:

## **DMV/Governmental Services Tax**

You may apply the exemption to a vehicle registration with the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles on a vehicle that you own that has a registration date due during the current fiscal year.

Manufactured/Mobile Home, Aircraft or Business Personal Property Account Number:

Documentation required for this exemption include a photocopy of your Nevada Driver's License or Identification card and a photocopy of your spouse's death certificate.

Note: This document must be signed before a Notary Public or a staff member of the Assessor Office A person who files a false affidavit or produces false proof to the County Assessor and obtains an exemption is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
