REGARDING TEMPORARY PROCEDURES
IN CIVIL CASES

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-6

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Sparks Justice Court has authority pursuant to NRS 4.157(c) to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the Court;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 virus presents concerns regarding public health, and the Court wishes to limit unnecessary in-person contact; and

WHEREAS, the Court has determined that Amended Administrative Order 2020-1 requires modification to reflect current conditions.

AND GOOD CAUSE BEING SHOWN,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective June 5, 2020, Section I.B. of Amended Administrative Order 2020-1 is amended, and the following interim procedures are adopted:

- Small Claims trials and Small Claims motion hearings will resume with priority given
 to cases in which proof of service of the Small Claims Complaint has been filed with the Court.

 All such matters will be heard remotely, either via teleconference or Zoom video hearings.
- All civil jury trials continue to remain suspended pending the availability of jury services through the Second Judicial District Court.
- 3. The Sparks Justice Court will resume issuing defaults under Justice Court Rule of Civil Procedure 55. In civil actions in which the summons and complaint were served prior to the filing date of this Order and the entry of default was suspended by Amended Administrative Order 2020-1, the Court requires the Plaintiff to provide the Defendant with a Notice of Intent

to Take Default that affords the Defendant a minimum of 14 calendar days to file an Answer before default may be entered. The attached Notice must be mailed to the Defendant at the Defendant's address where served or last known address if served at a location other than the Defendant's usual place of abode and filed with the Court.

4. The provisions in Amended Administrative Order 2020-1 staying the issuance of orders for the examination of judgment debtors are hereby amended to allow the examinations to occur through a teleconference or Zoom video hearing, upon motion to the Court, and heard by a Judge during the Court's civil calendar. The Governor's Emergency Directive 017 controls all post judgment collection matters, executions, and garnishments which remain stayed at this time.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order 2020-6 shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order, whichever occurs earlier.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
