*I HAVE BEEN ADVISED OF THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS:

- 1. Right to a speedy trial and, under certain circumstances and court's discretion, a conditional right to a jury trial.
- 2. The right to have the state prove the charges against me beyond a reasonable doubt.
- 3. The right to confront and cross-examine adverse witnesses.
- 4. The right to subpoena favorable witnesses.
- 5. The right to remain silent; to not testify; and not have it held against me.
- 6. The right to an attorney. (If a serious misdemeanor is involved involving jail time, then the right to a court appointed attorney if I cannot afford to hire my own.)
- 7. I understand the maximum penalty for a misdemeanor violation is up to 6 months in the county jail and a \$1,000.00 fine plus assessments and fees.
- 8. The right to a preliminary hearing in 15 days if greater than a general misdemeanor charge.
