

LEAVING YOUR PET IN A PARKED CAR COULD BE A **DEADLY MISTAKE** AND IT'S **AGAINST THE LAW!**

A person shall not allow a pet to remain unattended in a parked or standing motor vehicle if conditions, including, without limitation, extreme heat or cold, present a significant risk to the health and safety of the pet.

If a public safety officer reasonably believes that a violation of this section has occurred they may, without incurring civil liability, use any reasonable means necessary to protect the pet and to remove the pet from the motor vehicle.
