

Professional Services Agreement

WCRAS

Field services, stray animal sheltering, licensing, disaster response and evacuation

- Governance by Board of County Commissioners
- 42 Full -time staff
- Budget \$5 Million
- Special Revenue Fund \$.03/\$100

NHS

Pet adoptions, owner surrendered animals, spay/neuter and vaccinations

- Charitable, non - profit animal welfare organization
- Budget \$ 5 Million
- 90,000 lives saved since 2007
- 100 staff and 500 active volunteers




