

- Number of Re-offenses while in placement
- Successful or non-successful completion of treatment/placement

Due dates for quarterly reports for SFY 2016 is as follows:

1st Quarter- October 15, 2015 2nd Quarter- January 15, 2016 3rd Quarter- April 15, 2016

Final Report for 1st year of Contract-July 15, 2016

The school year enrollment numbers will be updated by June of each fiscal year with the current census prior to sending out the allocation to the counties.
