SUMMARY

Washoe County Board of County Commissioners is requested to approve the acceptance of a FFY14 Supplemental Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) from the State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management for \$10,148.00 and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget adjustments. This supplemental grant will fund Emergency Management Accreditation Program (EMAP) actions.


Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, secure and healthy communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

March 24, 2015 – The Board of County Commissioners accepted a 2013 Supplemental Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) from the State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management for \$16,000.00 [with County match of \$16,000.00]; and directed the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget adjustments.

BACKGROUND

This grant provides funding for the Washoe County Emergency Management program to include operating, planning, and training initiatives in preparing for all hazards. The EMAP is the national standard for emergency management programs like ours. The vision of the project is to validate our efforts to create a safer community through measurable standards of excellence. This accreditation project will ensure compliance with a national standard and aligns with our county strategic plan goals of safe, secure,



and healthy communities; stewardship of our community; as well as regional and community leadership.

GRANT AWARD SUMMARY

Project/Program Name: 2014 Supplemental Emergency Management Performance Grant

Scope of the Project: The EMPG program provides funding to assist local governments to sustain and enhance all-hazards emergency management capabilities.

Benefit to Washoe County Residents: The benefit of this funding is for emergency preparedness for the protection of life and property in the region from hazards and disasters.

On-Going Program Support: This grant is for specific deliverables, however, we will continue to seek grant funding to sustain the Emergency Management program.
