Appraiser Vice reviewed sales of comparable properties and recommended a reduction in the improvements due to an error of obsolescence being removed. She further testified this was the location of the old Tannenbaum Ski Resort.

Chairperson McAlinden closed the hearing.

Based on the evidence presented by the Assessor's Office and the Petitioner, on motion by Member Green, seconded by Member Woodland, which motion

duly carried, it was ordered that, due to an error of obsolescence being removed, the taxable value of the improvements on Parcel No. 048-070-10 be reduced to \$9,387, for a total taxable value of \$205,387. The Board also made the finding that with this adjustment, the land and improvements are valued correctly and the total taxable value does not exceed full cash value.
