Agenda Subject: "Confirmation of the temporary appointment of Battalion Chief Tim Leighton as Acting Fire Chief of the Sierra Fire Protection District, and delegation to the Chairman of the authority to negotiate an agreement covering additional terms of his temporary appointment to be ratified at the December 13, 2011 Board meeting. The terms of the temporary appointment may include, but not be limited to, temporary 20 percent increase in base salary effective November 8, 2011, which will continue during the period of time Leighton is so appointed, and approval of Leighton's return to his previous position as a Battalion Chief following this temporary appointment, with no reduction in seniority or related accruals."

Kurt Latipow, Fire Services Coordinator, stated that during the October 25, 2011 Fire Board meeting action was taken to accept the resignation of Fire Chief Michael Greene and appoint Battalion Chief Tim Leighton as Acting Chief with the

understanding that staff would return with a proposed adjustment to the compensation for Chief Leighton. He said there had been ongoing discussions and it was being recommended that the appointment be continued, the Chairman be delegated the authority to finalize the negotiations with Acting Chief Leighton on any additional terms of the temporary appointment and then the agreement be ratified during the December 13, 2011 Fire Board meeting. Mr. Latipow said the terms of the appointment may include, but not be limited to, a temporary 20 percent increase in base salary effective November 8, 2011, which would continue during the period of time Chief Leighton was appointed, and approval of Chief Leighton's return to his previous position as Battalion Chief following the temporary appointment with no reduction in seniority or related accruals.

There was no public comment on this item.

Chairman Breternitz inquired on the process of the negotiations. Acting Chief Leighton stated they were close to reaching an agreement and he felt that agreement would soon be solidified.
