DEER ORDINANCE.

The petition of W.G. Tallman and others asking that the Commissioners pass an ordinance fixing the open season for the killing deer, was presented to the board and on motion duly seconded and carried by the unanimous vote of the board, it was ordered that the following ordinance be adapted to-wit:

ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE OPEN SEASON FOR DEER IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to kill, catch, trap, wound, or pursue with intent to catch, capture, injure, or destroy any deer at any time during the year other than during a fifteen-day period to be known as the open season, beginning November 1st. of each and every year and ending November 15th. of each and every year, which said period of time, to-wit, from November 1st. to November 15th. is hereby designated by the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada as the open season for deer.

Sec. 2. The County and Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, is hereby authorized and directed to have this ordinance published twice in the Reno Evening Gazette, a daily newspaper of general circulation in Washoe County, Nevada, and said officer is further directed to spread this ordinance upon the Minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.

Sec. 3. The said County Clerk and Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, is hereby further authorized and directed to notify the Fish and Game Commission, immediately upon the passing of this ordinance, of the action taken by said Board of County Commissioners.
