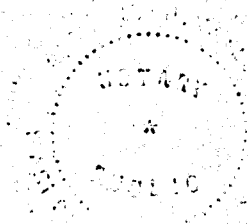

the appointment and compensation of  
certain of the members of the Planning  
Commission, the appropriation of funds  
for the expenses of the Planning Com-  
mission, and other matters properly re-  
lated thereto, and repealing all ordi-  
nances and parts of ordinances in con-  
flict therewith, was proposed on June 5,  
1959 by Commissioner McKenzie; final  
action of adoption was taken on June 26th,  
1959 by the following vote:

Ordinance No. 37

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE DEFINING A REGIONAL PLANNING DISTRICT: EMPOWERING A REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION TO ACT FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE IN ALL PLANNING DUTIES AND PLANNING FUNCTIONS: PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN OF THE MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION, THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THERewith.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Repeal of Section 6. Section 6. Appropriation of funds for commission use, of Ordinance No. 37, County of Washoe, is hereby repealed to read as follows:

Section 6. Appropriation of funds for commission use. The Board of County Commissioners shall appropriate funds annually for the use of the regional planning commission, such funds to be made a part of the budget of Washoe County. The regional planning commission shall have no authority to expend any funds of Washoe County in excess of those as appropriated, but may negotiate for gifts, Federal or State grants, or other funds, and may expend same only within the total amounts as acquired.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
