ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING LOCAL REGULATIONS FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE REVIEW OF TENTATIVE PLATS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Section 10C of Ordinance No. 51 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 10. Improvement Requirements.

C. All street improvements shall be graded, drained and surfaced in accordance with improvement plans as approved by the County Engineer. Plans and Specifications for subdivision improvements shall be submitted to the Engineer at the time the final plat is presented for checking. All streets shall be surfaced with a minimum of (2½) inches of Asphaltic Cement paving meeting the requirements of Section 401 of the Nevada Department of Highways Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction unless an alternative method of street surfacing is approved by the Board of County Commissioners at the time of approval of the tentative plat.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
