ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 55 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY CLERK TO CHARGE AND COLLECT AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR MARRIAGE LICENSES ISSUED BEFORE OR AFTER REGULAR OFFICE HOURS. PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF TO THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO." AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 55 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Regular office hours, for the purpose of this ordinance, shall be from the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 4:00 o'clock P.M., Monday to and including Friday, legal holidays and nonjudicial days excluded, effective January 1, 1971.

SECTION 2. The Board of County Commissioners find and hereby declare that an emergency exists, in that the hours of operation of the Marriage License Bureau must coincide with the hours adopted for the Office of Commissioner of Civil Marriages, which by law is effective January 1, 1971 and consequently, final action shall be taken immediately, and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication as required by N.R.S. 244.100.
