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Section 1. (a) The Sheriff of Washoe County, subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners, is hereby authorized to provide a uniform system of marking and signing streets and highways within Washoe County and such system of marking and signing shall correlate with and so far as possible conform with the system adopted in other parts of the State of Nevada.

(b) The Sheriff, subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners, is hereby authorized to determine the character or type and to place and erect upon the streets and highways traffic control signals at places where he shall deem them necessary for the safe and expeditious control of traffic. In so far as practicable, all types of traffic control signals shall be uniform as to type and location.

Section 2. Signs, signals and markings. The Sheriff, subject to the approval of the County Commissioners, shall cause appropriate signs to be erected and maintained, designating railroad crossings and such other signs and markings and traffic control signals as may be deemed necessary to direct and regulate traffic and to carry out the provisions of Chapter 484, N. R. S. and county ordinances, and such additional signs as may be appropriate to give notice of parking and other regulations.

Section 3. Obedience to Traffic Signs and Signals. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle, or the person in charge of any animal, or any pedestrian, to disobey the instructions of any official traffic sign or signal placed in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance and Chapter 484, N. R. S., unless otherwise directed by a police officer.

Section 4. Penalty. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in the sum of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not to exceed 6 months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
