SUMMARY: An ordinance amending Ordinance 84 to adopt the National Electrical Code, 1965 Edition.

BILL NO. 149

ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, BY ADOPTING THE 1965 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, COUNTY ORDINANCE 84 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE REGULATING THE INSTALLATION, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT, WIRING, AND DEVICES; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR ELECTRICAL WORK AND THE INSPECTION THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE COUNTY'S NON-LIABILITY IN CERTAIN CASES; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. County Ordinance 84, Section 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The National Electrical Code, 1965 Edition adopted by the National Fire Protection Association at its Annual Meeting, May 17-21, 1965 together with such changes as are necessary to make the same applicable to conditions in the County of Washoe, and with such other changes as are desirable, all of which changes are marked "Exhibit A" and placed on file in the office of the County Clerk of Washoe County, Nevada, shall be and hereby is adopted by reference, incorporated herein and made a part hereof as if set forth in full."
