ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 86 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY BY PRESCRIBING MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR THE USE, DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF HEATING AND COMFORT COOLING EQUIPMENT; REQUIRING A PERMIT AND INSPECTION FOR THE INSTALLATION, ALTERATION AND REPLACEMENT OF SAID EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF SUCH REQUIREMENTS; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 86 of the County of Washoe is hereby amended and shall read and provide as follows:


Section 1. The 1970 edition of the Uniform Mechanical Code and appendices is jointly sponsored by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials and the International Conference of Building Officials, a copy of which is placed on file in the office of the County Clerk of Washoe County, Nevada, together with such changes as are necessary to make the same applicable to conditions in the County of Washoe and such other changes as are desirable, which changes are contained in that document marked Exhibit "A", attached hereto, shall be and hereby is adopted by reference; incorporated herein, and made a part hereof, and shall regulate all matters contained therein.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100 and NRS 244.105.

EXHIBIT A

1970 EDITION UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE

Whenever the term Administrative Authority is used in the Code it shall be construed to mean the Washoe County Building and Safety Department.

Whenever the term Assistant is used in the Code, it shall be construed to mean the Assistant Building and Safety Inspector employed by the County of Washoe Building and Safety Department.

PART 1 - Administrative

CHAPTER 2 - Organization and Enforcement

SECTION 203 Board of Appeals - add paragraph.
The Building Inspector shall collect a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each notice of appeal which shall be deposited to the credit of the County General Fund.
