NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an Ordinance requiring the registration with the Washoe County Sheriff and fingerprinting and thumbprinting of employees including Licensees of gambling houses and employees including Licensees of establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold at retail for consumption on the premises; providing for the issuance and revocation of employment certificates; providing for penalties for violation thereof and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, was proposed on December 5th, 1960 by County Commissioner, Benjamin F. Winn, final action of adoption was taken on December 20th, 1960 by the following vote:

3 SUMMARY--Provides for the registration, fingerprinting and
4 thumbprinting of employees and licensees of gambling houses and/or
5 establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold in Washoe
6 County, State of Nevada.

7 AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION WITH THE WASHOE COUNTY
8 SHERIFF AND FINGERPRINTING AND THUMBPRINTING OF EMPLOYEES IN-
9 CLUDING LICENSEES OF GAMBLING HOUSES AND EMPLOYEES INCLUDING
10 LICENSEES OF ESTABLISHMENTS WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD
11 AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES; PROVIDING FOR THE
12 ISSUANCE AND REVOCATION OF EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATES; PROVIDING
13 FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES
14 OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

15 THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

16 SECTION I:

17 Whenever used in this ordinance, unless the context
18 otherwise requires,

19 (a) "Employees of gambling houses" shall mean all
20 licensees, dealers and other persons in any manner engaged in
21 or connected with the operation of any game or device for which
22 a license is required by the terms of Ordinance No. 31 of the
23 Book of Revised ordinances of Washoe County, excepting only
24 games and slot machines operated mechanically and without atten-
25 dants;

26 (b) "Employees of establishments where alcoholic bever-
27 ages are sold at retail for consumption on the premises" shall
28 mean all licensees, bartenders, waiters and all other persons
29 serving alcoholic beverages to patrons for consumption on the
30 premises in connection with any business for which a license is
required by the terms of liquor ordinance No. 1 Book of Revised
Ordinances of Washoe County;

(c) "Alcoholic beverages" shall mean beer, lager beer,
ale, porter or wine, spirituous liquor or similar beverages one-
half of one per cent or more of alcohol by volume;

1 (d) "Licensees" shall include all persons whose names
2 are required to be stated in the applications for gambling licenses
3 as specified in Ordinance No. 31 Book of Revised Ordinances of
4 Washoe County and in applications for licenses to sell and dispose
5 of beer, lager beer, ale, porter, wine, spirituous liquor and
6 similar beverages as specified in Liquor Ordinance No. 1 Book of
7 Revised Ordinances of Washoe County.

8 (e) "Employment certificate" shall mean a certificate
9 issued by Washoe County Sheriff indicating that the individual
10 as defined in paragraphs (a) and/or (b) of this section has com-
11 plied with the provisions of this ordinance ;

12 (f) "Convicted" shall mean a finding of guilt resulting
13 from a plea of guilty, the decision of a court or magistrate or
14 the verdict of a jury, irrespective of the pronouncement of
15 judgment or the suspension thereof.

16 SECTION II.

17 It is hereby declared to be the policy of this ordinance
18 that all establishments where gambling games are conducted or
19 operated or where gambling devices are operated, or establishments
20 where alcoholic beverages are sold at retail for consumption on
21 the premises in the County of Washoe, State of Nevada, shall be
22 licensed and controlled so as to better protect the public
23 health, safety, morals, good order and general welfare of the in-
24 habitants of the County of Washoe, State of Nevada, and it is
25 hereby made the duty of the Washoe County Sheriff to investigate
26 the legal qualifications of each applicant for license under
27 Ordinance No. 31 and Liquor Ordinance No. 1 of Washoe County,
28 and applicants for employment for certificates as herein required
29 and defined, before any such license issues or employee certi-
30 ficate granted, to the end that the license shall not be issued
or employment certificate granted to unqualified or disqualified

1 persons or to unsuitable persons. To better define the policy of
 2 this ordinance, the following persons are declared to be not
 3 qualified or satisfactory to hold any license under the provisions
 4 of Ordinance No. 31 and Liquor Ordinance No. 1 of Washoe County,
 5 or to be granted an employment certificate as herein defined:

6 (a) A person who shall have been convicted of:

7 1. A felony or any other crime which under the
 8 laws of this state would amount to a felony;

9 2. Any crime of which fraud or intent to defraud
 10 was an element whether committed in this state or
 11 elsewhere;

12 3. Larceny in any degree;

13 4. Buying or receiving stolen property;

14 5. Unlawful entry of a building;

15 6. Unlawful possession or distribution of narcotic
 16 drugs;

17 7. Illegally using, carrying or possessing a
 18 pistol or other dangerous weapon;

19 (b) A person under the age of twenty-one (21) years;

20 (c) A person who does not possess a good moral character;

21 (d) A person whom the Board of County Commissioners shall
 22 determine is not a suitable person to receive a license under the
 23 provisions of this Ordinance, having due consideration for the
 24 proper protection of the public health, safety, morals, good
 25 order and general welfare of the inhabitants of the County of
 26 Washoe, State of Nevada.

27 SECTION III

28 It shall be the duty of the Washoe County Sheriff:

29 (a) To receive and process the applications hereinafter
 30 provided for in Section IV.

(b) To take the thumb and fingerprints of all appli-
 cants, and to forthwith send a copy of such imprints to the Bureau
 of Identification of the State of California and one copy of the
 same to the Identification Bureau of the Federal Bureau of In-
 vestigation at Washington, D.C., with the request that all

1 information as to the previous record, if any, of such persons be
2 forthwith transmitted to the Washoe County Sheriff. The informa-
3 tion, if any, received as aforesaid, shall be treated as confi-
4 dential and shall only be made accessible to the elective offi-
5 cers of the county, to the employer of such persons where ap-
6 plicable, and to law enforcement officers.

7 (c) To make and keep such records systematically and in
8 such manner as similar records are usually kept and so as to
9 make the data contained therein readily available and to permit
10 an easy interchange of records with other like bureaus and age-
11 ncies.

12 (d) To investigate into the qualifications of all ap-
13 plicants for licenses or employment certificates as provided for
14 in this ordinance.

15 (e) To institute through the proper authorities, pro-
16 ceedings, actions and prosecutions for the enforcement of the pro-
17 vision of this ordinance relating to the penalties, liabilities and
18 punishment of persons for refusal or neglect to comply with the
19 provisions of this ordinance.

20 (f) To recommend to the Board of County Commissioners
21 of Washoe County the revocation of any license or employment cer-
22 tificate issued under the provisions of this ordinance when a
23 licensee or employee has refused to comply with, or has violated
24 any of the provisions of this ordinance, or who has been found
25 guilty by any court of competent jurisdiction of any violation
26 of this Ordinance, or for misrepresentation of a material fact
27 by the applicant in obtaining a license or employment certificate
28 hereunder, or when a licensee or employee shall be deemed to be no
29 longer a suitable person to hold a license or employment certifi-
30 cate under the provisions of this Ordinance having due consideration

1 of the public health, safety, morals, good order and general wel-
2 fare of the inhabitants of Washoe County, State of Nevada.

3 SECTION IV

4 Any employee or licensee of a gambling house and/or of
5 establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold at retail for
6 consumption on the premises, before commencing to act or serve
7 in that capacity after the effective date of this ordinance, shall
8 submit and have approved by the Washoe County Sheriff a written
9 application to the office of the Washoe County Sheriff, setting
10 forth the following information: applicant's name, age, sex,
11 present address, and address of all residences and descriptions of
12 all occupations and businesses for the past five (5) years prior to
13 such application, together with the applicant's statement under
14 oath setting forth any convictions of those crimes enumerated
15 in paragraph (a) Section II of this ordinance prior to the date of
16 said application, and shall submit to the taking of his or her
17 thumbprints and fingerprints, for filing in the said office. The
18 information received as aforesaid shall be treated as confiden-
19 tial and shall only be made accessible to the elective officers
20 of this county, the employer of such person if applicable, and to
21 law enforcement officers.

22 (a) Every licensee or employee submitting an application
23 under the provisions of this ordinance shall first pay to the
24 County of Washoe the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) as a condition
25 precedent to having issued to him or her the license or employment
26 certificate, which said sum shall be used to defray the expense
27 of the investigation and shall in any event be retained by the
28 County of Washoe, State of Nevada. Every person seeking a
29 replacement, reissuance or renewal of an original certificate
30 previously issued to him or her shall pay to the County of Washoe,

1 State of Nevada, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) for such replaced
2 or reissued or renewed certificate.

3 All employment certificates shall be valid for one year and
4 renewable annually provided the applicant shall not become in-
5 eligible.

6 SECTION V.

7 Any license or employment certificate issued under the
8 provisions of this Ordinance may be revoked by the Board of
9 County Commissioners when it shall appear to the satisfaction of
10 the majority of the members of the Board of County Commissioners
11 that:

12 (a) The licensee or employee has subsequent to the is-
13 suance of the said license or employment certificate been con-
14 victed of an offense of such a nature as to cause a majority of
15 the Board of County Commissioners to conclude that such licensee
16 or employee is no longer a suitable or qualified person to hold
17 a license or employment under the provisions of this Ordinance
18 in the County of Washoe, State of Nevada.

19 (b) For making any false statement in an application
20 for a license or employment certificate;

21 (c) Refusal or neglect to comply with any of the provi-
22 sions of this Ordinance.

23 SECTION VI

24 Upon compliance by any employee or licensee with the
25 provisions of this Ordinance, the Washoe County Sheriff shall is-
26 sue an employment certificate to such employee or licensee, sub-
27 ject to the revocation as provided in Section V.

28 SECTION VII

29 It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation
30 operating any licensed gambling game or establishment where

1 intoxicating beverages are served for retail consumption on the
 2 premises in the County of Washoe, from and after the effective
 3 date of this Ordinance, to employ, or to retain in his, her or
 4 its employ, any person required by the terms of this Ordinance
 5 to register with the Washoe County Sheriff unless such person shall
 6 have so registered and shall have been fingerprinted as herein
 7 provided and shall have in his or her possession an Employment
 8 Certificate issued by the Washoe County Sheriff evidencing the
 9 same, or to employ any such person whose employment certificate
 10 has been revoked under the terms of this ordinance.

11 SECTION VIII

12 Any person violating or failing to comply with any of the
 13 provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished
 14 by a fine in any sum of less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)
 15 but not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or by imprisonment not
 16 exceeding six (6) months in the Washoe County Jail or by both
 17 such fine and imprisonment; and any violation of this ordinance
 18 by a licensee shall be sufficient ground for the revocation
 19 of such license.

20 THIS ORDINANCE shall be in effect from and after its passage
 21 and approval.
