NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that an Ordinance amending the Ordinance requiring the registration with the Washoe County Sheriff and fingerprinting and thumbprinting of employees including LI- censees of gambling houses and em- ployees including licensees of establish- ments where alcoholic beverages are sold at retail for consumption on the premises; providing for penalties for vio- lation thereof and repealing all Ordin- ances or parts of Ordinances in con- flict herewith, was proposed on January 5th, 1962, by Commissioner Clarkson. Fi- nal action of adoption was taken on January 20th, 1962, by the following vote:

3 tration, thumbprinting, of employees and licensees of
4 gambling houses and/or establishments where alcoholic
5 beverages are sold in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

8 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE REGIS-
9 TRATION WITH THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF AND FINGERPRINTING
10 AND THUMBPRINTING OF EMPLOYEES INCLUDING LICENSEES OF
11 GAMBLING HOUSES AND EMPLOYEES INCLUDING LICENSEES OF ES-
12 TABLISHMENTS WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD AT RETAIL
13 FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE
14 AND REVOCATION OF EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATES; PROVIDING FOR
15 PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDI-
16 NANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

17 The Sections of Ordinance 93 to be amended, deleted or
18 modified are Sections 1-a, 1-b, Section 3 paragraph b,
19 Section 4-a; Sections 1-g, 1-h and 4-b are to be added
20 thereto, and all enumerated changes are set forth here-
21 in.

22 THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

23 SECTION 1. Whenever used in this ordinance, unless the context
24 otherwise requires,

- 25 (a) "Employees of gambling houses" shall mean all em-
26 ployees, whatsoever, regardless of type of employ-
27 ment, who are employed upon the premises or grounds
28 of an establishment where gambling is carried on.
- 29 (b) "Employees of establishments where alcoholic bever-
30 ages are sold at retail for consumption on the pre-
mises" shall mean all employees, whatsoever, regard-
less of type of employment, who are employed upon the
premises or grounds of an establishment where alco-
holic beverages are sold at retail for consumption
on the premises.
- (c) "Alcoholic beverages" shall mean beer, lager beer,
ale, porter, wine, spirituous liquor or similar bever-
ages one-half of one per cent or more of alcohol by
volume;
- (d) "Licensees" shall include all persons whose names are
required to be stated in the applications for gamb-
ling licenses as specified in Ordinance No. 31 Book
of Revised Ordinances of Washoe County and in

1 applications for licenses to sell and dispose of
2 beer, lager beer, ale, porter, wine, spirituous
3 liquor and similar beverages as specified in Li-
quor Ordinance No. 1 Book of Revised Ordinances of
Washoe County.

4 (e) "Employment certificate" shall mean a certificate
5 issued by Washoe County Sheriff indicating that
6 the individual as defined in paragraphs (a) and/or
(b) of this section has complied with the provi-
sions of this ordinance;

7 (f) "Convicted" shall mean a finding of guilt resulting
8 from a plea of guilty, the decision of a court or
9 magistrate or the verdict of a jury, irrespective
of the pronouncement of a judgment or the suspen-
sion thereof;

10 (g) "An employee" is anyone who receives a salary or
11 receives a percentage of profits from the business
establishment other than a licensee;

12 (h) "Premises" shall mean the total grounds, including
13 all unimproved property as well as all buildings lo-
14 cated at the area designated in the license issued
by the appropriate authority to carry on the desig-
nated type of business.

15
16 SECTION 2. It is hereby declared to be the policy of this ordi-
17 nance that all establishments where gambling games
18 are conducted or operated or where gambling devices
19 are operated, or establishments where alcoholic bev-
20 erages are sold at retail for consumption on the pre-
21 mises in the County of Washoe, State of Nevada, shall
22 be licensed and controlled so as to better protect
23 the public health, safety, morals, good order and
24 general welfare of the inhabitants of the County of
25 Washoe, State of Nevada, and it is hereby made the
26 duty of the Washoe County Sheriff to investigate
27 the legal qualifications of each applicant for li-
28 cense under Ordinance No. 31 and Liquor Ordinance No.
1 of Washoe County, and applicants for employment
for certificates as herein required and defined,
before any such license issues or employee certifi-
cate granted, to the end that the license shall
not be issued or employment certificate granted to
unqualified or disqualified persons or to unsuitable
persons. To better define the policy of this ordi-
nance, the following persons are declared to be not
qualified or satisfactory to hold any license under
the provisions of Ordinance No. 31 and Liquor Ord-
inance No. 1 of Washoe County, or to be granted an
employment certificate as herein defined:

29 (a) A person who shall have been convicted of:
30 1. A felony or any other crime which under the laws

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of this state would amount to a felony;

- 2. Any crime of which fraud or intent to defraud was an element whether committed in this state or elsewhere;
- 3. Larceny in any degree;
- 4. Buying or receiving stolen property;
- 5. Unlawful entry of a building;
- 6. Unlawful possession or distribution of narcotic drugs;
- 7. Illegally using, carrying or possessing a pistol or other dangerous weapon;

- (b) A person under the age of twenty-one (21) years;
- (c) A person who does not possess a good moral character;
- (d) A person whom the Board of County Commissioners shall determine is not a suitable person to receive a license under the provisions of this Ordinance, having due consideration for the proper protection of the public health, safety, morals, good order and general welfare of the inhabitants of the County of Washoe, State of Nevada.

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of the Washoe County Sheriff:

- (a) To receive and process the applications hereinafter provided for in Section 4.
- (b) To take the thumb, fingerprints, and photographs of all applicants and to forthwith send a copy of such imprints to the Identification Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation at Washington, D.C., with the request that all information as to the previous record, if any, of such persons be forthwith transmitted to the Washoe County Sheriff. The information, if any, received as aforesaid, shall be treated as confidential and shall only be made accessible to the elective officers of the county, to the employer of such persons where applicable, and to law enforcement officers.
- (c) To make and keep such records systematically and in such manner as similar records are usually kept and so as to make the data contained therein readily available and to permit an easy interchange of records with other like bureaus and agencies.
- (d) To investigate into the qualifications of all applicants for licenses or employment certificates as provided for in this ordinance.

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(e) To institute through the proper authorities, proceedings, actions and prosecutions for the enforcement of the provision of this ordinance relating to the penalties, liabilities and punishment of persons for refusal or neglect to comply with the provisions of this ordinance.

(f) To recommend to the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County the revocation of any license or employment certificate issued under the provisions of this ordinance when a licensee or employee has refused to comply with, or has violated any of the provisions of this ordinance, or who has been found guilty by any court of competent jurisdiction of any violation of this Ordinance, or for misrepresentation of a material fact by the applicant in obtaining a license or employment certificate hereunder, or when a licensee or employee shall be deemed to be no longer a suitable person to hold a license or employment certificate under the provisions of this Ordinance having due consideration of the public health, safety, morals, good order and general welfare of the inhabitants of Washoe County, State of Nevada.

SECTION 4. Any employee or licensee of a gambling house and/or of establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold at retail for consumption on the premises, before commencing to act or serve in that capacity after the effective date of this ordinance, shall submit and have approved by the Washoe County Sheriff a written application to the office of the Washoe County Sheriff, setting forth the following information: applicant's name, age, sex, present address, and address of all residences and descriptions of all occupations and businesses for the past five (5) years prior to such application, together with the applicant's statement under oath setting forth any convictions of those crimes enumerated in paragraph (a) Section 2 of this Ordinance prior to the date of said application, and shall submit to the taking of his or her thumbprints and fingerprints, for filing in the said office. The information received as aforesaid shall be treated as confidential and shall only be made accessible to the elective officers of this county, the employer of such person if applicable, and to law enforcement officers.

(a) Every licensee or employee submitting an application under the provisions of this ordinance shall first pay to the County of Washoe the sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars as a condition precedent to having issued to him or her the license or employment certificate, which said sum shall be used to defray the expense of the investigation and shall in any event be retained by the County of Washoe, State of Nevada. Every person seeking a replacement, reissuance or

1 renewal of an original certificate previously is-
2 sued to him or her shall pay to the County of Washoe,
3 State of Nevada, the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for
4 such replaced or reissued or renewed certificate.

5 All employment certificates shall be valid for one
6 year and renewable annually provided the applicant
7 shall not become ineligible.

8 (b) A person who shall not have been fingerprinted by
9 the Washoe County Sheriff's Office for a period of
10 time of five (5) years shall submit his fingerprints
11 every five (5) years in a similar manner as that pro-
12 vided in Section 3 of this ordinance, and shall pay
13 the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) as provided in Sec-
14 tion 4-a of this Ordinance.

15 **SECTION 5.** Any license or employment certificate issued under
16 the provisions of this Ordinance may be revoked by
17 the Board of County Commissioners when it shall ap-
18 pear to the satisfaction of the majority of the
19 members of the Board of County Commissioners that:

20 (a) The licensee or employee has subsequent to the is-
21 suance of the said license or employment certifi-
22 cate been convicted of an offense of such a nature
23 as to cause a majority of the Board of County Com-
24 missioners to conclude that such licensee or employee
25 is no longer a suitable or qualified person to hold
26 a license or employment under the provisions of this
27 Ordinance in the County of Washoe, State of Nevada;

28 (b) For making any false statement in an application for
29 a license or employment certificate;

30 (c) Refusal or neglect to comply with any of the provi-
sions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. Upon compliance by any employee or licensee with
the provisions of this Ordinance, the Washoe County
Sheriff shall issue an employment certificate to
such employee or licensee, subject to the revoca-
tion as provided in Section 5.

SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corpora-
tion operating any licensed gambling game or es-
tablishment where intoxicating beverages are served
for retail consumption on the premises in the County
of Washoe, from and after the effective date of
this Ordinance, to employ, or to retain in his, her
or its employ, any person required by the terms
of this Ordinance to register with the Washoe County
Sheriff unless such person shall have so registered
and shall have been fingerprinted as herein pro-
vided and shall have in his or her possession an Em-
ployment Certificate issued by the Washoe County

Sheriff evidencing the same, or to employ any such person whose employment certificate has been revoked under the terms of this ordinance.

SECTION 8. Any person violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine in any sum of less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) but not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding six (6) months in the Washoe County Jail or by both such fine and imprisonment; and any violation of this ordinance by a licensee shall be sufficient ground for the revocation of such license.

SECTION 9. Those provisions of any other Washoe County ordinance in conflict with this amendment are hereby repealed, but only to the extent that they are in conflict with this Ordinance.

THIS ORDINANCE shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
