ORDINANCE NO. 105

7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 OF COUNTY ORDINANCE  
8 NO. 105 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR LOCAL  
9 REGULATIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF VACATION PERIODS,  
10 COMPUTATION AND AMOUNT OF SICK LEAVE AND COMPULSORY  
11 RETIREMENT AGES FOR EMPLOYEES OF WASHOE COUNTY AND  
12 OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO."

13 THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DOES ORDAIN:

14 Section 1. Section 7 of County Ordinance No. 105 is hereby  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 7. Leave of absences.

17 A. Leave of absence.

18 Upon application to the Board of County Commissioners  
19 by any appointed officer and employee, the Board  
20 of County Commissioners may grant such officer  
21 or employee a leave of absence without pay.

22 B. Maternity leave of absences.

23 Upon application to the Board of County Commissioners  
24 by an appointed officer or employee, the Board of  
25 County Commissioners may grant such officer or  
26 employee a maternity leave of absence without pay  
27 if 1. the employee has been employed by the County  
28 for at least one year, 2. the leave of absence  
29 will not extend beyond six (6) months, 3. that  
30 accrued sick leave is not considered part of the  
maternity leave of absence.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after  
its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
