NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that
Bill No. 110, Ordinance No. 106, an
Ordinance to amend an ordinance
entitled "An Ordinance defining a Regional
Planning District; empowering a Regional
Planning Commission to act for and
on behalf of the County of Washoe in
all planning duties and planning functions;
providing for the appointment and compensation
of members; the appropriation
of funds for expenses thereof; and other
matters properly related thereto" was
proposed on the 15th day of February,
1965 by Commissioner Streeter, and was
passed on said date as an emergency
measure, by the following vote of the
Board of County Commissioners:

SUMMARY: An Ordinance amending Ordinance 106 to make the powers of the Lake Tahoe Planning Commission advisory only.

BILL NO. 110

ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND COUNTY ORDINANCE 106 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING A REGIONAL PLANNING DISTRICT: EMPOWERING A REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION TO ACT FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE IN ALL PLANNING DUTIES AND PLANNING FUNCTIONS: PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION OF MEMBERS: THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR EXPENSES THEREOF: AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. County Ordinance 106, Section 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Representation of County on Lake Tahoe Planning Commission.

The County of Washoe shall be represented as set forth hereafter on a regional planning Commission to be known as the Lake Tahoe Planning Commission. It is expressly declared that the Planning Commission hereby created is solely for the purpose of advising the Board of County Commissioners and the Regional Planning Commission of Reno, Sparks, and Washoe County, as created by County Ordinance 101, with regard to problems of planning and zoning in the district created by Section 1 of this Ordinance. None of the duties and functions specified in Chapter 278 of the Nevada Revised Statutes shall be fulfilled by the Lake Tahoe Planning Commission. It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners in creating the Lake Tahoe Planning Commission that it shall have only advisory powers and that all powers, duties and functions of planning commissions as specified in Chapter 278 of NRS or elsewhere by law in the County of Washoe including the district created herein shall be fulfilled by the Regional Planning Commission of Reno, Sparks and Washoe County, created by County Ordinance 101."

Section 2. County Ordinance 106, Section 8 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. Repeal

Nothing contained herein shall serve to repeal or limit in any way the powers, duties or functions of the Regional Planning Commission of Reno, Sparks and Washoe County as created by County Ordinance 101. All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict."

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS §244.100.
