ORDINANCE NO./40

AN ORDINANCE INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR ADDING TO THE INCLINE VILLAGE GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT POWERS RELATING TO PUBLIC RECREATION; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION AND NOTICE OF HEARING THEREON

WHEREAS, the County of Washoe, in the State of Nevada, is a County incorporated and operating under the laws of the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of May, 1961, this Board adopted Ordinance No. 97, entitled, "An Ordinance Creating the Incline Village General Improvement District Proposed for Paving, Curbs and Gutters, Sidewalks, Storm Drainage, Sewer Disposal and Water Supply; and Declaring an Emergency";

WHEREAS, in addition to the powers therein authorized and granted to such District, the Legislature has now authorized such districts to have powers relating to public recreation;

WHEREAS, this Board initiated proceedings to vest such powers in said District by Ordinance No. 131 entitled, "An Ordinance Initiating Proceedings for Adding to the Incline Village General Improvement District Powers Relating to Public Recreation; and Providing for the Publication and Notice of Hearing Thereon", adopted May 5, 1965;

WHEREAS, after proceedings to that end had and taken by this Board pursuant to said ordinance, it purported to vest such powers in said District by Ordinance No. 97, entitled, "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 97 by Adding to the Incline Village General Improvement District Powers Relating to Public Recreation", adopted June 15, 1965;

WHEREAS, the validity of said ordinances has been questioned for the reason that said Ordinance No. 131 does not contain a statement that the ordinance adding such powers will be based upon this Board's finding that the public convenience and necessity require the addition of such power to such District and that the addition of such power to said District is economically sound and feasible; and

WHEREAS, said question cannot be conclusively established without a decision by the Nevada Supreme Court and the public interest and economy will be served by taking the proceedings herein set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, IN THE STATE OF NEVADA, DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Proceedings are hereby initiated for the adding of additional powers to the Incline Village General Improvement District pursuant to N.R.S. 318.077.

Section 2. The additional powers proposed to be added to the powers of the Incline Village General Improvement District are:

(k) To acquire, construct, reconstruct, improve, extend or better lands, works, systems and facilities for public recreation.

Section 3 The ordinance adding such power will be based on the Board's finding:

- (a) That the public convenience and necessity require the addition of such power, and
- (b) That the addition of such power is economically sound and feasible.

Section 4. Mon'DAY, the 25th day of October, 1965, at the hour of 10:30 o'clock A.M in the Chambers of said Board, County Sheriff's Office Building, Room 103, Reno, Nevada, are hereby fixed as the time and place when and where it will have a hearing on the adding of such powers and when and where all persons interested therein may be heard

Section 5. The County Clerk shall give notice by publication of the intention of this Board to add such powers to such District, which notice shall set forth a statement of such powers, and the time and place of hearing, in the NEVADA STATE JOURNAL, a newspaper of general circulation in the District, and being the newspaper most likely to give notice to interested persons in this matter, once a week for three consecutive weeks, the first of which shall be at least fifteen days prior to the day of hearing.

Section 6. The County Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published by title, together with a separate statement to the effect that typewritten copies of the Ordinance are available for inspection at the office of the County Clerk by all interested persons, together with the names of the County Commissioners voting for or against its passage, in the NEVADA STATE JOURNAL, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Washoe, and being the newspaper which is most likely to give notice to.persons interested herein, at least once a week for a period of two weeks before this Ordinance shall become effective.
