OE COUNTY TREASURER, AND WASH-
OE COUNTY RECORDER AND AUDI-
TOR; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFEC-
TIVE DATE OF SUCH SALARIES; PRO-

SUMMARY: An ordinance enacted pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 321 of the 1963 Statutes of Nevada setting annual salaries for certain elected County officials of Washoe County.

BILL NO. 155

ORDINANCE NO. 148

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF, WASHOE COUNTY CLERK, WASHOE COUNTY ASSESSOR, WASHOE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY, WASHOE COUNTY TREASURER, AND WASHOE COUNTY RECORDER AND AUDITOR; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH SALARIES; PROVIDING THAT SUCH ORDINANCE MAY NOT BE AMENDED OR REPEALED DURING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF SUCH OFFICERS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Nevada State Legislature enacted Chapter 321 of the 1963 Statutes of Nevada which required the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County in June of 1966 to fix the annual salaries for certain elected Washoe County officials; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the power created by Chapter 321 of the 1963 Statutes of Nevada the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada desires by this Ordinance to set the annual salaries of the herein described Washoe County elected officials;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. The annual salary of the following described Washoe County elected officials is hereby fixed as follows:
 Washoe County Sheriff \$11,000.00 Dollars;
 Washoe County Clerk and Ex Officio Clerk of the District Court and of the Board of County Commissioners \$15,000.00 Dollars; Washoe County Assessor \$15,000.00 Dollars; Washoe County District Attorney \$18,000.00 Dollars;
 Washoe County Treasurer \$13,200.00 Dollars;
 Washoe County Recorder and Auditor \$15,000.00 Dollars.

Section 2. The annual salary of each of the Washoe County elected officials described herein shall become effective on the first Monday in January, 1967 and be fixed for the ensuing term of office.

Section 3. This Ordinance may not be amended or repealed during the ensuing term of office of any of the herein described Washoe County elected officials.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS §244.100.

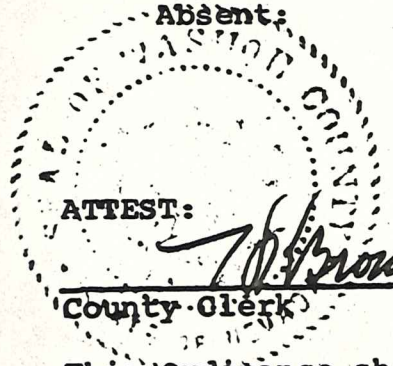
