ORDINANCE NO. 148

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 148, BILL NO. 155, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE ANNUAL SALARIES OF THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF, WASHOE COUNTY CLERK, WASHOE COUNTY ASSESSOR, WASHOE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY, WASHOE COUNTY TREASURER, AND WASHOE COUNTY RECORDER AND AUDITOR; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH SALARIES; PROVIDING THAT SUCH ORDINANCE MAY NOT BE AMENDED OR REPEALED DURING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF SUCH OFFICERS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Ordinance No. 148, Bill No. 155, is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
