BILL NO. 279

ORDINANCE NO. 185

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT ALL FINES AND FORFEITURES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCES BE DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL FUND OF WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

All fines and forfeitures for violations of the Washoe County ordinances shall be deposited in the general fund of Washoe County, Nevada.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
