## ORDINANCE NO. 212

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 212 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PRIMARY AND SECONDARY TRUCK ROUTES WITHIN WASHOE COUNTY."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 212 is hereby amended to read as follows:

  - FAS 823 in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Section 4 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 212 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 1. Calaneva Drive in its entirety.
  - 2. Country Club Drive from State Route 28 to Lakeshore Boulevard.

  - 5. Lakeshore Boulevard from Village Boulevard to Country Club Drive.
  - 6. Mayes Boulevard from West End Shopping Center to Southwood Boulevard.
  - 7. North Enterprise in its entirety.
  - 8. Oriole Way in its entirety.
  - 9. Parvin Road in its entirety.
  - 10. Reservoir Drive from Wassou Road to State Route 28.
  - 11. Southwood Boulevard in its entirety.
  - 12. State Line Road from Wassou Road to Entrance--Cal Neva
  - 13. Sweetwater Road from State Route 28 to Parvin Road.
  - Tanager Street in its entirety.
  - 15. Village Boulevard from State Route 28 to Lakeshore Boulevard.
  - 16. Wassou Road from State Line Road to Reservoir Drive.
- B. Washoe Lake Basin
  - 1. East Lake Boulevard in its entirety.
  - FAS 709 in its entirety.
