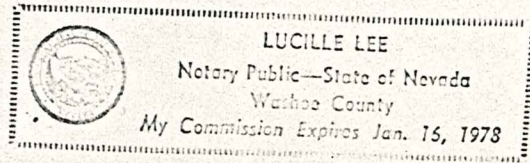

Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 439, Ordinance No. 276, entitled "An Ordinance creating County Commissioner Districts based upon population in Washoe County, Nevada, in compliance with the local government reapportionment law; and providing other matters properly relating thereto," was adopted on July 25, 1975 by Commissioners Scott, Rusk, Crow, Nelson and Gaunt, all voting aye.

SUMMARY: Creates Washoe County Commissioner Districts based upon population in compliance with Chapter 244 of NRS and the Local Government Reapportionment Law.

ORDINANCE NO. 276

AN ORDINANCE CREATING COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS BASED UPON POPULATION IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA, IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT REAPPORTIONMENT LAW; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

As used in this Ordinance "Assembly Districts" means those Washoe County legislative districts composed of specified enumeration districts as set forth in NRS 218.080 (2b).

SECTION 2.

In compliance with Chapter 244 of NRS and the Local Government Reapportionment Law, five County Commissioner districts in Washoe County, Nevada are hereby created as follows:

- A. County Commissioner District No. 1 is composed of Washoe County Assembly districts No. 24 and No. 25.
- B. County Commissioner District No. 2 is composed of Washoe County Assembly districts No. 23 and No. 26.
- C. County Commissioner District No. 3 is composed of Washoe County Assembly districts No. 27 and No. 28.
- D. County Commissioner District No. 4 is composed of Washoe County Assembly districts No. 30 and No. 31.
- E. County Commissioner District No. 5 is composed of Washoe County Assembly districts No. 29 and No. 32.

SECTION 3.

- A. At the general election in 1976 and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 1 and one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 4, for terms of four years.
- B. At the general election in 1978 and every four years thereafter, there shall be elected one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 2, one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 3, and one county commissioner from County Commissioner District No. 5, for terms of four years.
- C. The members of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, covered by the provisions of this section, as constituted on the effective date of this Ordinance, shall, pursuant to law, continue to hold office for the terms for which they were elected and shall represent the County Commissioner Districts created hereunder as follows:
 - 1. Commissioner Richard Scott shall be the commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 1.
 - 2. Commissioner Dwight Nelson shall be the commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 2.

- 3. Commissioner Robert Rusk shall be the commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 3.
- 4. Commissioner Gerald Grow shall be the commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 4.
- 5. Commissioner Ken Gaunt shall be the commissioner representing County Commissioner District No. 5.

SECTION 4.

In the event a vacancy occurs in the office of any county commissioner before the expiration of the term of that commissioner, such vacancy shall be filled in the manner provided by law by a qualified elector from the County Commissioner District created herein represented by said commissioner.

SECTION 5.

Washoe County Ordinance No. 186, passed as an emergency measure December 27, 1971, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 6.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
