Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 451, Ordinance No. 286,
amending Ordinance No. 221 entitled "An ordinance amending an ordinance
designating congested areas within the unincorporated area of Washoe
County for purposes of animal control; prohibiting animals trespassing
on private residential property or County property within congested
area; providing for the impounding of animals found in violation of the
provisions of the ordinance; providing regulations of impounding, destruc-
tion or auction, and release of impounded animals; providing penalties
for the noncompliance of the provisions hereof; and other matters properly
relating thereto," was adopted on September 25, 1975 by Commissioners
Scott, Crow, Rusk, Nelson and Gaunt all voting aye.

ORDINANCE NO. 286

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CONGESTED AREAS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY FOR PURPOSES OF ANIMAL CONTROL; PROHIBITING ANIMALS TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OR COUNTY PROPERTY WITHIN CONGESTED AREAS; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF ANIMALS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING REGULATIONS OF IMPOUNDING, DESTRUCTION OR AUCTION, AND RELEASE OF IMPOUNDED ANIMALS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE NONCOMPLIANCE OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The title to Washoe County Ordinance No. 221 is hereby amended to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CONGESTED AREAS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY FOR PURPOSES OF ANIMAL CONTROL; PROHIBITING ANIMALS TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OR COUNTY PROPERTY WITHIN CONGESTED AREAS; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF ANIMALS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING REGULATIONS OF IMPOUNDING, DESTRUCTION OR AUCTION, AND RELEASE OF IMPOUNDED ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR IMPOUNDING OF LIVESTOCK IN THE COUNTY WHICH ARE ENDANGERING PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY, PUBLIC SAFETY, THEMSELVES, OR OTHER ANIMALS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE NONCOMPLIANCE OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

SECTION 2.

Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 221 is hereby amended by the addition of the following sentence: The animal control officer, his authorized representatives, and every peace officer while on duty, are hereby authorized to take up and impound all livestock in the County which are endangering private or public property, public safety, themselves, or other animals.

SECTION 3.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Washoe finds that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

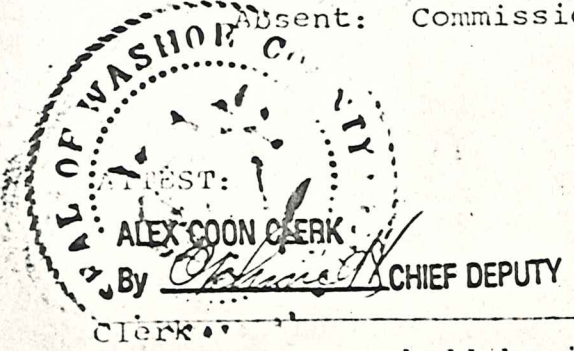
