ORDINANCE NO. 294

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING UNAUTHORIZED PARKING OF VEHICLES ON POSTED PARKING LOTS AND PROPERTY OPERATED, OWNED OR CONTROLLED BY WASHOE COUNTY; AUTHORIZING TOWING AWAY OF VEHICLES ILLEGALLY PARKED ON SUCH LOTS OR PROPERTY AT THE EXPENSE OF VEHICLE OWNERS; PROVIDING PENALTIES; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO," AS AMENDED.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 220 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3.

- A. It is unlawful at any time for any member of the public or any county officer or employee to park in red-painted, white-striped, or yellow-painted zones, except:
 - 1. County employees delivering mail and employees of the General Services Department may park in yellow-painted zones while engaged in ongoing maintenance or repair work or other official duties in adjacent county buildings or areas.
 - Representatives of public utility companies may park in yellow-painted zones when engaging in official business relating to adjacent county buildings or areas.
- B. Enforcement of the provisions of this ordinance may be waived at the direction of the County Manager in order to accommodate special occasions or circumstances.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
