Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 484, adopting Ordinance No. 317, repealing Ordinance No. 120, Bill No. 87, entitled "An Ordinance requiring biennial examinations of food handlers; declaring public policy; defining terms; requiring Food Handler's Cards; specifying expiration dates and fees; providing for physical and medical examinations; prohibiting employment under certain circumstances; providing for appeals; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto." was adopted on June 25, 1976 by Commissioners Scott, Crow, Nelson and Gaunt all voting aye, with Commissioner Rusk being absent.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 120, BILL NO. 87, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING BIENNIAL EXAMINATIONS OF FOOD HANDLERS; DECLARING PUBLIC POLICY; DEFINING TERMS; REQUIRING FOOD HANDLER'S CARDS; SPECIFYING EXPIRATION DATES AND FEES; PROVIDING FOR PHYSICAL AND MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS; PROHIBITING EMPLOYMENT UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; PROVIDING FOR APPEALS; PROVIDING PENALTIES; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Washoe County Ordinance No. 120, Bill No. 87, is hereby repealed.



SECTION 2.
This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
