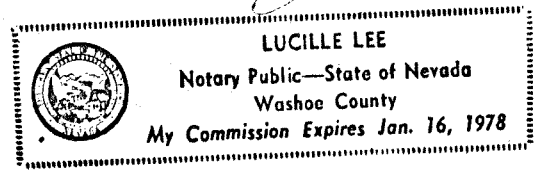

NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 491, Ordinance No. 325 amending Washoe County Ordinance No. 133 entitled "An ordinance amending an ordinance making unlawful the deposits of rubbish and other offensive matter on public or private highways or upon public or private property in the unincorporated area of the County of Washoe, providing for the appointment of a special officer to enforce this ordinance, prescribing penalties for violation thereof, and other matters relating thereto," was adopted on August 3, 1976 by Commissioners Scott, Gaunt and Nelson all voting aye, with Commissioners Rusk and Grow being absent.

ORDINANCE NO. 325

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE MAKING UNLAWFUL THE DEPOSITS OF RUBBISH AND OTHER OFFENSIVE MATTER ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE HIGHWAYS OR UPON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SPECIAL OFFICER TO ENFORCE THIS ORDINANCE, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 133 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in the sum of not more than \$500.00. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforced by the Washoe County District Health Department.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.

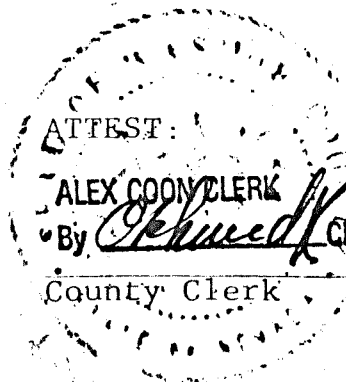
