Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 494, Ordinance No. 329 entitled "An ordinance prohibiting the taking and carrying away, driving away or floating away of a vessel the property of another without the intent to permanently deprive the owner thereof but without the consent of the owner thereof; prescribing penalties for the violation thereof, and other matters properly relating thereto," was adopted on September 7, 1976 by Commissioners Scott, Crow, Rusk, Nelson and Gaunt.

SUMMARY: Provides that the taking and carrying away, driving away or floating away of a vessel of another without the intent to permanently deprive the owner thereof but without the consent of the owner thereof is unlawful.

BILL NO. 494

ORDINANCE NO. 329

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE TAKING AND CARRYING AWAY, DRIVING AWAY OR FLOATING AWAY OF A VESSEL THE PROPERTY OF ANOTHER WITHOUT THE INTENT TO PERMANENTLY DEPRIVE THE OWNER THEREOF BUT WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER THEREOF; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Definitions.

- A. Vessel: The term "vessel" as used in this ordinance means every type of watercraft used or capable of being used as a means of transportation on water.
- B. Owner: The term "owner" as used in this ordinance means a person or other legal entity having the lawful use or control or the right to the use and control of a vessel.

SECTION 2.

Every person who takes and carries away, drives away or floats away the vessel of another within Washoe County without the intent to permanently deprive the owner thereof but without the consent of the owner of such vessel is guilty of a misdemeanor.

SECTION 3.

Every person who is in possession of a vessel without the consent of the owner of such vessel is presumed to have taken, carried away, driven away, or floated away said vessel.

SECTION 4.

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not to exceed six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
