NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
Notice is hereby given that Bill No.
513, Ordinance No. 344, amending
Ordinance No. 226, entitled "An
Ordinance providing for the licensing
and inoculation against rabies of
dogs in designated congested areas
of the unincorporated area of
Washoe County; provides for special
permits to maintain in excess of three
dogs; prohibits dogs running at large
or trespassing on private property;
provides for the quarantine of biting
animals; provides for the designation
of a poundkeeper and the im-
poundment of animals found in
violation of the provisions of this
ordinance; providing for regulations
for impoundment, destruction and
release of animals; prohibits the
keeping of noisy animals; provides
for the impounding of all dogs en-
dangering private or public property,
public safety, themselves, or other
animals; provides penalties for
noncompliance with the provisions
hereof; and other matters properly
relating thereto" by designating the
Comstock Drive-Valley Road area as
a congested area, was adopted on
June 7, 1977 by Commissioners Scott,
Rusk, Nelson, Gaunt and Farr.

ORDINANCE NO. 344

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND INOCULATION AGAINST RABIES OF DOGS IN DESIGNATED CONGESTED AREAS OF THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDES FOR SPECIAL PERMITS TO MAINTAIN IN EXCESS OF THREE DOGS; PROHIBITS DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE OR TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY; PROVIDES FOR THE QUARANTINE OF BITING ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A POUND-KEEPER AND THE IMPOUNDMENT OF ANIMALS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS FOR IMPOUNDMENT, DESTRUCTION AND RELEASE OF ANIMALS; PROHIBITS THE KEEPING OF NOISY ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF ALL DOGS ENDANGERING PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY, PUBLIC SAFETY, THEMSELVES, OR OTHER ANIMALS; PROVIDES PENALTIES FOR NONCOMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY DESIGNATING THE COMSTOCK DRIVE-VALLEY ROAD AREA AS A CONGESTED AREA.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Section 21 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 226 is hereby amended by the addition of a new paragraph X, which paragraph shall read as follows (all other paragraphs of Section 21 remaining the same):

X. Comstock Drive-Valley Road Area
All that certain area lying outside of the incorporated city limits of the City of Reno within the following described lands: All of Section 35, Easterly of North Virginia Street, and the West one half (W 1/2) of Section 36, T.20N., R.19E., M.D.B. &M.

SECTION 2. Effective date.
This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
