ORDINANCE NO. 398

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES FOR UNIFORMLY HANDLING GRANT MONEYS UNDER GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SOURCES; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND DECLARATIONS; IMPOSING DUTIES ON COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY PERMITTING THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT CERTAIN GRANT APPLICATIONS WITHOUT THE PRIOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 366 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. County Commissioners to Approve Grant Applications; Duties of Recipients, County Comptroller.

- A. Except as otherwise provided in this section, an officer, employee, department or agency of the County shall not submit an application for a grant of money from any source without prior review and tentative approval by the Board of County Commissioners.
- B. The provisions contained in paragraph A of this section do not apply:
 - 1. If, because of an impending deadline for submission of an application, prior review and tentative approval by the Board of County Commissioners is not feasible. In that event, the County manager may give emergency authorization to submit the application. The County Manager's authorization shall then be reviewed by the Board and is subject to its ratification at its next regular meeting.
 - 2. Whenever the Washoe County Sheriff's Department submits an application for a grant of money from the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration (LEAA). In that event, the Department shall notify the Board of County Commissioners of the application by submitting a copy of the application to the Board through the County Manager immediately after the application is submitted to LEAA.
 - C. If the grant is awarded, that fact shall be communicated to the Board of County Commissioners and the amount of cash match, if any, required from the County shall be indicated.
- D. Upon final approval by the Board of County Commissioners, the applicant may accept the grant on behalf of the County and shall advise the County Comptroller of all pertinent grant details in order that the accounting records of the County may clearly reflect the grant activity.

- All grant money received shall be transmitted by the applicant to the County Treasurer for deposit by him to the appropriate fund account.
- Not later than September 30 of each year, the County Comptroller shall provide the Board of County Commissioners with a written report of all grant activity in the County for the previous fiscal year.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
