NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 572, Ordinance No. 404, en-
titled "An Ordinance designating congested areas within the unin-
corporated area of Washoe County for purposes of animal control;
prohibiting animals trespassing on private residential property or
County property within congested areas; providing for the impound-
ing of animals found in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance;
providing regulations of impounding, destruction or auction, and
release of impounded animals; provides for impounding of livestock
in the County which are endangering private or public property,
public safety, themselves, or other animals; providing penalties for
the noncompliance of the provisions hereof; and other matters pro-
perly relating thereto" by providing for confidentiality of certain in-
formation received by the Animal Control Officer was adopted on
December 5, 1978, by Commissioners Rusk, Nelson, Brown and
Stoess, with Commissioner Farr voting "no".

ORDINANCE NO. 404

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CONGESTED AREAS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY FOR PURPOSES OF ANIMAL CONTROL; PROHIBITING ANIMALS TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OR COUNTY PROPERTY WITHIN CONGESTED AREAS; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF ANIMALS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING REGULATIONS OF IMPOUNDING, DESTRUCTION OR AUCTION, AND RELEASE OF IMPOUNDED ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR IMPOUNDING OF LIVESTOCK IN THE COUNTY WHICH ARE ENDANGERING PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY, PUBLIC SAFETY, THEMSELVES, OR OTHER ANIMALS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE NONCOMPLIANCE OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY PROVIDING FOR CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION RECEIVED BY THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Washoe County Ordinance No. 221 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section which shall read as follows:

SECTION 10. Notification of Animal Control Officer of violation of ordinance.

Any person who observes a violation of any provision of this ordinance may notify the Animal Control Officer of the violation either orally or by written communication. Such notification shall be for the sole use of the Animal Control Officer and the name and address of the person providing such notification shall remain confidential unless:

1. Permission to disclose the name and address is given by that person to the Animal Control Officer; or
2. Disclosure of the name and address of that person is required in any judicial proceeding.

SECTION 2. Existing sections 10 to 13, inclusive, of Washoe County Ordinance No. 221 are hereby renumbered as sections 11 to 14, inclusive.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after its proposal, passage and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
