AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A WASHOE COUNTY PURCHASING DEPARTMENT HEADED BY A PURCHASING AND CONTRACTS ADMINISTRATOR; INCLUDING THE PREPARATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING PURCHASING POLICIES, PRACTICES AND PROCEDURES, ALL TO BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; REPEALING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 159; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO," BY CHANGING THE AMOUNT OF AUTHORIZED PURCHASES BY THE PURCHASING AND CONTRACTS ADMINISTRATOR.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
Section 2 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 296 is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is hereby established the Washoe County Purchasing Department, headed by a Purchasing and Contracts Administrator. The Purchasing and Contracts Administrator shall, subject to the provisions of this ordinance and applicable provisions of state law:

- A. Purchase all supplies, materials, equipment and contractual services required by the agencies in amounts or estimated amounts of \$5,000 or less, and submit to the Board of County Commissioners for award all purchases of supplies, materials, equipment and contractual services in amounts or estimated amounts in excess of \$5,000 in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Purchasing Act.
- B. Use standard specifications wherever they are applicable to purchase orders and contracts, and insure compliance with such specifications through adequate inspection of deliveries.
- C. Transfer between agencies supplies, materials and equipment which are no longer needed by a holding agency but which can be used by the receiving agency.
- D. Sell personal property in compliance with NRS and the Local Government Purchasing Act.
- E. Develop, with the approval of the District Attorney as to legal sufficiency, standard forms and conditions to invitations to bid and purchase orders and contracts, develop and prescribe the use by agencies of other forms required in carrying out the provisions of this ordinance, and amend or eliminate any such forms.
- F. Prepare and propose to the Board of County Commissioners rules and regulations regarding purchasing policies, practices and procedures not in

conflict with or inconsistent with the Local Government Purchasing Act or other applicable state statutes. Such rules and regulations and amendments thereto upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners shall be in full force and effect and shall be adhered to by every employee and officer of Washoe County.

Be responsible for administration of the County's G. fixed assets inventory as required by Ordinance No. 231.
