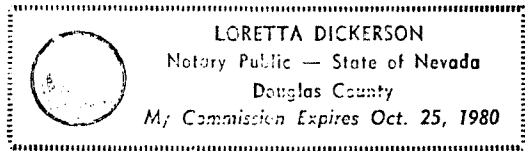

ORDINANCE NO. 467

AN ORDINANCE INITIATING PROCEEDINGS FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE SUN VALLEY WATER DISTRICT #2 PROPOSED FOR FURNISHING WATER FACILITIES AND SANITARY SEWER FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR WRITTEN NOTICE OF HEARING AND HEARING ON THE CREATION OF THE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the County of Washoe, in the State of Nevada, is a County incorporated and operating under the laws of the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County (herein designated as the "Board") is authorized and empowered under NRS 318.050 and NRS 318.055, in addition to powers elsewhere conferred upon the Board, to initiate proceedings for the organization of a water and sanitary sewer district.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, IN THE STATE OF NEVADA, DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Proceedings are hereby initiated for the formation of a water and sanitary sewer district pursuant to Chapter 318, Title 25 of the Nevada Revised Statutes.

SECTION 2.

The name of the proposed district will be the Sun Valley Water District #2 (hereinafter designated as the "District".)

SECTION 3.

The general purposes for which the District is proposed to be formed are:

- (a) To acquire, construct, reconstruct, improve, extend or better a works, system or facilities for the supply, storage and distribution of water for private and public purposes.
- (b) To operate, maintain, and repair the improvements acquired by the District, including without limitation the maintenance and repair of all facilities of the District relating to any basic power enumerated above which the District is authorized to exercise, and in connection therewith to exercise from time to time any one, all or any combination of the incidental powers provided in Chapter 318, Title 25 of the Nevada Revised Statutes and any law supplemental thereto, except as may be otherwise provided in the Chapter and Title.
- (c) To construct, reconstruct, improve, extend or better the sanitary sewer system or any part thereof, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, mains, laterals, wyes, tees, meters and collection, treatment and disposal plants.
- (d) To sell any product or byproduct thereof and acquire the appropriate outlets within or without the district and to extend the sewer lines of the district thereto.

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SECTION 4.

The general description of the boundaries of the District are the coterminous exterior boundaries of the composite and consolidated area consisting of the several parcels of land described in the exhibit entitled Exhibit "A" hereto attached and by reference made a part hereof.

SECTION 5.

The lands within the District are within seven miles from the boundaries of the City of Reno, an incorporated city of the State of Nevada. Accordingly, all members of the Board have unanimously agreed to the initiating of proceedings for the organization of the District within the lands, the boundaries of which contravene the seven-mile limitation described in the statute, as permitted by NRS 318.055.

SECTION 6.

Tuesday, July 8, 1980, at the hour of 9:30 o'clock a.m., in the Chambers of the Board, 1205 Mill Street, Reno, Nevada, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where the Board will have a hearing on the creation of the District, after which the Board will make its findings whether or not the ordinance creating said District is required by necessity and public convenience and whether or not the creation of the District is economically sound and feasible. All interested persons may be heard at the hearing.

SECTION 7.


The County Clerk shall mail written notice to all property owners within the District of the intention of the Board to establish the District. The notice shall set forth the name, statement of purposes, general description and time and place of hearing.
