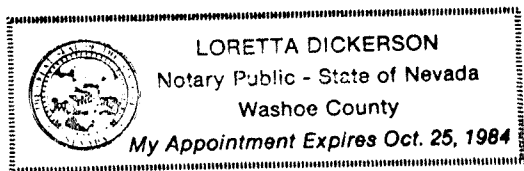

NOTICE IS HEREBY  
GIVEN that Bill No. 657,  
Ordinance No. 486, amending  
Ordinance No. 170 entitled, "An  
Ordinance creating and  
establishing the office of Public  
Defender; provides for ap-  
pointment and removal,  
qualifications and com-  
pensation; establishing duties,  
provides limitations upon  
criminal and civil practice of the  
public defender and his deputies;  
provides for appointment of a  
staff, annual reports; and  
provides other matters properly  
relating thereto" by prohibiting  
the public defender and his  
assistant and deputy public  
defenders from engaging in the  
private practice of law was  
adopted on February 17, 1981, by  
Commissioners Farr, Ferrari,  
Underwood and Williams with  
Commissioner Brown being  
absent.

SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 170 by prohibiting the Public Defender and his Assistant and Deputy Public Defenders from engaging in the private practice of law.

BILL NO. 657

ORDINANCE NO. 486

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC DEFENDER; PROVIDES FOR APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL, QUALIFICATIONS AND COMPENSATION; ESTABLISHING DUTIES, PROVIDES LIMITATIONS UPON CRIMINAL AND CIVIL PRACTICE OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER AND HIS DEPUTIES; PROVIDES FOR APPOINTMENT OF A STAFF, ANNUAL REPORTS; AND PROVIDES OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY PROHIBITING THE PUBLIC DEFENDER AND HIS ASSISTANT AND DEPUTY PUBLIC DEFENDERS FROM ENGAGING IN THE PRIVATE PRACTICE OF LAW.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 5 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 170 is hereby repealed and the following language is inserted in its stead.

SECTION 5. Compensation.


1. The compensation of the Public Defender shall be fixed by the Board of County Commissioners.
2. The Public Defender and his Assistant and Deputy Public Defenders shall not engage in the private practice of law while employed in the Office of the Public Defender.
3. The Board of County Commissioners shall provide office space, furniture, equipment and supplies for the use of the Public Defender suitable for the conduct of the business of his office. Each such item shall be a charge against the County. In any case, funds for all such charges, costs, or cash-allowance must first have been authorized by budgetary provision, or otherwise been authorized and made available therefore, by the Board of County Commissioners.


