ORDINANCE NO. 5/2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF COUNTY PARK SYSTEM FACILITIES; DESIGNATING THE WASHOE COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO ADMINISTER THE SYSTEM; PERMITTING PROMULGATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS TO SUPPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF FEES; PROVIDING PROHIBITIONS AND A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY CHANGING THE METHOD OF ADOPTING FEES FOR USING COUNTY PARK FACILITIES.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 27 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 229 is hereby amended to read as follows:

## SECTION 27. Payment for use of facilities.

- A. If the Board of County Commissioners has established a fee for the use of a facility within the county park system, no person may use, occupy or be within the boundaries of the facility unless he has paid the applicable fee.
- 3. An envelope system shall be instituted to collect fees, as is used by the Nevada State Parks System and the United States Forest Service. The system shall be utilized by Washoe County residents only.

SECTION 2. Section 28 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 229 is hereby amended to read as follows:

## SECTION 28. Fees; method of establishing.

- A. The director shall submit to the Board of County Commissioners a schedule which defines categories and time limits of use of facilities within the county park system and which sets forth proposed fees for each category of use. The categories, time limits and fees shall become effective upon entry of an Order of the Board of County Commissioners.
- B. The director may provide to the Board of County Commissioners a schedule of proposed fees for the sale or rental of personal property intended for use within a facility of the county park system. The fees shall become effective upon entry of an Order of the Board of County Commmissioners.

C. Any category of use, time limit or fee in effect at the date of passage of this Ordinance shall remain effective until changed pursuant to the terms of this section.

SECTION 3. Section 41 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 229 is hereby repealed.
