# ORDINANCE NO. 513

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING EXCAVATIONS IN PUBLIC STREETS AND ALLEYS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS THEREFOR; PROVIDING TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE REPLACEMENT AND REPAIR OF STREETS AFTER EXCAVATIONS; PROVIDING PENALTIES; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR STREET CUTS ON IMPROVED AREAS ADJACENT TO COUNTY ROADS, STREETS OR ALLEYS AND BY RAISING FEES FOR INSPECTIONS MADE AFTER STREET CUTS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

#### SECTION 1.

Section 6 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 243 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 6. Street cut permits; Classification according to surface to be cut; fees for inspection services made after street cuts; exceptions.

- A. For the purpose of establishing service fees for inspections of street cuts, road surfaces shall be classified as follows:
  - Class A: Roads, streets or alleys which are surfaced with asphalt pavement.
  - Class B: Roads, steets or alleys having gravel or decomposed granite surfaces.
  - 3. Class C: The area within the right-of-way of any road, street or alley which lies between the edge of the finished roadway and the outside edge of any improvement adjacent to said roadway, including, without limitation, areas occupied by roadway shoulders, ditches, curbs, gutters and sidewalks.
- B. Except as provided in Sections 3 and 4, a service fee shall be paid to the Public Works Department for each street cut permit as follows:

Class A permit (cuts of 500 square feet or less). . . . . \$27.50

Class B permit (cuts of 500 square feet or less). . . . . \$27.50

Class C permit (cuts of 500 square feet or less). . . . . \$27.50

Any permit for a street cut of more than 500 square feet shall require payment of an additional service fee of \$0.05 for every square foot in excess of 500 square feet.

The service fee for a Class A permit on a roadway which as a surface less than 5 years old shall be additionally increased at the rate of 10 percent per month for each unlapsed month within the 5 year period following surfacing of said roadway. Only one street cut permit shall be required for any single excavation. If any excavation includes an area which requires a Class A permit, the service fee for the permit shall be based upon the issuance of a Class A permit and shall include all additional charges set forth in this section.

The service fee authorized by this section shall be doubled if excavation work is illegally commenced prior to the issuance of a street cut permit.

C. There is no permit required for test holes, cores, borings, pole anchors or pole holes, or any other individual openings less than 3 feet square in area. In such cases the surface shall be completely restored by the excavating contractor in accordance with technical specifications contained in sections 11 to 53, inclusive.

### SECTION 2.

Section 56 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 243 is hereby repealed.
