AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE IN THE COUNTY OF WASHOE REGULATING THE INSTALLATION, ALTERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF PLUMBING AND DRAINAGE SYSTEMS AND WATER DISTRIBUTION AND SEWER SYSTEMS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR SAID PLUMBING AND INSTALLATION WORK AND THE INSPECTION THEREOF; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH" BY INCREASING SERVICE FEES FOR ISSUING PERMITS AND MAKING INSPECTIONS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 20.7 of Exhibit A of Washoe County Ordinance No. 324 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 20.7 Service fees for permits and inspections.
- (a) Before issuing a permit under this section, a service fee in the amount set forth on the following Schedule of Service Fees, plus an additional fee in accordance with paragraph (d), must be paid by the applicant.

In addition for each plumbing fixture or trap or set of fixtures on one trap (including water, drainage piping and backflow	
protection therefor)	2.00
For each building sewer and each trailer park sewer.	5.00

For each private sewage disposal system	10.00
For each water heater and/or vent	2.00
For each gas piping system of one (1) or four (4) outlets	2.00

For	each gas piping system of five (5) or more, per outlet	.50
For	installation, alteration or repair of water piping and/or water treatment equipment	2.00
For	each industrial waste pretreatment interceptor, including its trap and vent, excepting kitchen type grease interceptors functioning as fixture traps	2.00
For	repair or alteration of drainage or vent piping.	2.00
For	each lawn sprinkler system on any one meter, including backflow protection devices therefor.	2.00
For	vacuum breakers or backflow protective devices on tanks, vats, etc., or for installation on unprotected plumbing fixtures including necessary water pipingone (1) to four (4)	2.00
Five	e (5) or more, each	.50

- (b) The service fee for issing a permit for the installation of a community sewer system and/or a community water distribution system as defined by this Code shall be \$3.00 for each \$1,000 valuation or part thereof up through \$10,000 of the estimated cost of said installation; for each additional \$1,000 valuation or part thereof, the fee shall be \$2.00 per thousand or part thereof. The additional service fee set forth in paragraph (d) shall be added to such fee to obtain the total service fee for issuing the permit.
- (c) For each special inspection or reinspection, an additional fee of \$5.00 and 10 cents per mile on a round-trip basis, plus the additional service fee set forth in paragraph (d), will be charged.
- (d) Additional service fees.
 - An additional service fee in the amount of 9.9 percent of the basic service fee must be paid upon application for any permit or upon any inspection required pursuant to this Code.
 - 2. If first approved in the manner required by Section 5 of Chapter 150, Statutes of Nevada, 1981, an additional annual service fee in the amount of 9.9 percent of the basic service fee must be paid in 1982, and cumulatively each year

thereafter, upon application for a permit or upon an inspection required pursuant to this Code.
