 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Bill No. 721, Ordinance No. 549, amending Ordinance No. 221, entitled, "An ordinance designating congested areas within the unincorporated area of Washoe County for purposes of animal control; prohibiting animals trespassing on private residential property or county property within congested areas; providing for the impounding of animals found in violation of the provisions of this ordinance; providing regulations of impounding, destruction or auction, and release of impounded animals; provides for impounding of livestock in the County which are endangering private or public property, public safety, themselves, or other animals; and other matters properly relating thereto" by making unlawful certain trespass by or running at large of livestock under any circumstances was adopted on July 13, 1982, by Commissioners Farr, Brown, Underwood, and Williams with Commissioner Ferrari being absent. ORDINANCE NO. 549

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CONGESTED AREAS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY FOR PURPOSES OF ANIMAL CONTROL; PROHIBITING ANIMALS TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY OR COUNTY PROPERTY WITHIN CONGESTED AREAS; PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF ANIMALS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING REGULATIONS OF IMPOUNDING, DESTRUCTION OR AUCTION, AND RELEASE OF IMPOUNDED ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR IMPOUNDING OF LIVESTOCK IN THE COUNTY WHICH ARE ENDANGERING PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY, PUBLIC SAFETY, THEMSELVES, OR OTHER ANIMALS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE NONCOMPLIANCE OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY MAKING UNLAWFUL CERTAIN TRESPASS BY OR RUNNING AT LARGE OF LIVESTOCK UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 221 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Prohibits Livestock from Trespassing or Running at Large

1. It is unlawful for any livestock, in congested areas of the County:
 - A. To trespass on private property.
 - B. To run at large on any public highway, street, alley, park, school or playground.

A violation of this subsection is committed by the owner or person having custody, control or possession of the livestock.

2. The animal control officer, his authorized representatives and peace officers, while on duty, may take up and impound such livestock and any other livestock which are endangering property, public safety, themselves or any other animal.
