NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Bill No. 726, Ordinance No. 553, amending Ordinance No. 170, entitled, "An Ordinance creating and establishing the office of Public Defender; provides for appointment and removal, qualifications and compensation; establishing duties, provides limitations upon criminal and civil practice of the Public Defender and his deputies; provides for appointment of a staff, annual reports; and provides other matters properly relating thereto" by modifying the annual reporting requirements of the Public Defender and making technical corrections thereto was adopted on Tuesday, September 14, 1982, by Commissioners Farr, Ferrari, Underwood, and Brown, with Commissioner Williams being absent.

SUMMARY: Amends the annual reporting requirements of the Public Defender; makes minor technical corrections.

ORDINANCE NO. 553

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC DEFENDER; PROVIDES FOR APPOINTMENT AND REMOVAL, QUALIFICATIONS AND COMPENSATION; ESTABLISHING DUTIES, PROVIDES LIMITATIONS UPON CRIMINAL AND CIVIL PRACTICE OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER AND HIS DEPUTIES; PROVIDES FOR APPOINTMENT OF A STAFF, ANNUAL REPORTS; AND PROVIDES OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO", BY MODIFYING THE ANNUAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER AND MAKING TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 170 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Appointment and Removal by County Commissioners

The office of the Public Defender shall be filled by appointment by the Board of County Commissioners. The Public Defender shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 2. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 170 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Assistant or deputy public defenders

1. Subject to the prior approval of the Board of County Commissioners, the Public Defender may appoint such deputy or assistant attorneys, clerks, investigators, stenographers and other employees as are necessary to enable him to carry out his responsibilities.
2. The compensation of all persons so appointed shall be fixed by the Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 3. Section 8 of Ordinance No. 170 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 8. Annual Reports

The Public Defender shall make an annual report to the Board of County Commissioners covering all cases handled by his office during the preceding year. The annual report shall contain any and all information requested by the Board of County Commissioners and shall include, but not be limited to, at least the following information:

- a) The number of new cases received during the report period;
- b) The number of cases closed during the report period;
- c) The dollar amount of all attorneys fees levied upon Public Defender clients;
- d) The dollar amount of all revenue collected during the report period, and
- e) The number of cases received during the report period consisting of the following:
 - 1. Felonies.
 - 2. Gross misdemeanors.
 - 3. Misdemeanors.
 - 4. Municipal ordinance violations.
 - 5. Parole violations.
 - 6. Modifications of probation or sentence.
 - 7. Miscellaneous proceedings.
 - 8. Juvenile proceedings.
 - 9. Insanity hearings.
 - 10. Probation revocations
 - 11. Supreme Court appeals.
 - 12. District Court appeals.
 - 13. Extradition proceedings.
 - 14. Post conviction proceedings.

SECTION 4. Section 9 of Ordinance No. 170 is hereby repealed.


