ORDINANCE NO. 584

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY REPEALING AND ADDING PROVISIONS ESTABLISHING RESTRICTED SPEED ZONES IN THE SOUTHEAST, SOUTHWEST, HORIZON HILLS NORTH, WEST RED ROCK, STATE LINE AND NORTHEAST AREAS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 70.300 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

70.300 Restricted speed zones: Southwest Area. Restricted speed zones are hereby established for the following public streets, roads and highways within the unincorporated area of the county with the maximum vehicular speeds allowable set opposite the names of such public streets, roads and highways:

Quilici Road......25 m.p.h.

SECTION 2. Section 70.315 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

70.315 Restricted speed zones: Southeast Area. Restricted speed zones are hereby established for the following public streets, roads and highways within the unincorporated area of the county with the maximum vehicular speeds allowable set opposite the names of such public streets, roads and highways:

Longley Lane from its intersection with Rock Boulevard to its intersection with South Virginia Street: As Posted
SECTION 3. Section 70.345 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
70.345 Restricted speed zones: Horizon Hills North and West-Red Rock and State Line. Restricted speed zones are hereby established for the following public streets, roads and highways within the unincorporated area of the county with the maximum vehicular speeds allowable set opposite the names of such public streets, roads and highways: Red Rock Road
SECTION 4. Section 70.360 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
70.360 Restricted speed zones: Northeast. Restricted speed zones are hereby established for the following public streets, roads and highways within the unincorporated area of the county with the maximum vehicular speeds allowable set opposite the names of such public streets, roads and highways: Queen Way
