SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Code by creating the Washoe County Planning Commission.

BILL NO. <u>783</u> ORDINANCE NO. <u>610</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 110 OF THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY ADDING THERETO PROVISIONS CREATING THE WASHOE COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Chapter 110 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 through 11, inclusive, of this ordinance.

SECTION 2.

110.0150 Washoe County Planning Commission: Creation. The Washoe County planning commission is hereby created, pursuant to NRS 278.030, to perform all the duties and functions delegated to a county planning commission by the terms of NRS 278.010 to 278.630, inclusive, except for such duties and functions which may be delegated by the board of county commissioners to the regional planning commission.

SECTION 3.

110.0151 Membership and terms of office.

1. The Washoe County planning commission shall consist of seven members.

2. The term of office of each member shall be four years, or until his successor takes office, except that the terms of two of the members first appointed shall be three years, the terms of two of the members first appointed shall be two years and the term of one of the members first appointed shall be one year.

SECTION 4.

110.0152 Appointment and qualifications; vacancies.

1. The chairman of board of county commissioners shall appoint, subject to the approval of said board, the members of the Washoe County planning commission.

- 2. The members shall hold no other public office and shall be residents of the unincorporated area of Washoe County and registered voters therein at the time of their appointment and continuously throughout their term of office.
- 3. Vacancies occurring otherwise than through the expiration of a member's term shall be filled for the unexpired term.

SECTION 5.

110.0153 Compensation. All members of the Washoe County planning commission shall serve as such without compensation, excepting reasonable travel expenses and subsistence allowances made necessary in the fulfillment of their official duties.

SECTION 6.

110.0154 Removal from office. Any member of the Washoe County planning commission may be removed from office, following a public hearing, by a majority vote of the board of county commissioners for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance of office.

SECTION 7.

110.0155 Meetings and records.

The Washoe County planning commission shall hold at

least one regular meeting in each month.
2. It shall adopt rules for the transaction of business and shall keep a record of its resolutions, transactions, findings and determinations, which record shall be a public record.

SECTION 8.

110.0156 Chairman and other officers: Election.

- The Washoe County planning commission shall elect its chairman from among the appointed members. The term of chairman shall be I year without eligibility for reelection for a consecutive 1 year term, except that a chairman elected to fill the remainder of a predecessor's term shall be eligible for reelection to a full 1 year
- In addition to electing its chairman, the Washoe County planning commission shall create and fill such other of its offices as it may determine.

SECTION 9.

110.0157 Employees:

The Washoe County planning commission may appoint such employees as it may deem necessary for its work, whose appointment, promotion, demotion and removal shall be subject to the same provisions of law as govern other corresponding civil employees of the county.

2. The commission may also contract with county planners, engineers, architects and other consultants for such

services as it may require.

SECTION 10.

110.0158 Funding. The expenditures of the Washoe County

planning commission, exclusive of gifts, shall be within the amounts appropriated for the purpose by the board of county commissioners, which shall provide the funds, equipment and accommodations necessary for the commission's work.

SECTION 11.

110.0159 Construction of language. With the exception of sections 110.010 through 110.015, inclusive, of this code, the term "regional planning commission" or "planning commission" wherever used in this code shall mean the Washoe County planning commission.
