AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 110 OF THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY REDUCING THE REQUIRED NOTICE FOR A CHANGE OF LAND USE FROM 15 DAYS TO 10 DAYS AND CORRECTING CERTAIN INTERNAL REFERENCES THEREIN.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 110.233 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Notice of hearing on appeals: Mailing. Notice of hearing on appeals from decisions granting or denying variances, recommending the issuance, denial or revocation of special use permits and recommending approval or denial of changes of land use shall be given by the clerk of the board of county commissioners by mailing a notice of hearing to the appellant, the applicant and to all owners of real property who are notified by the administrator of the planning commission pursuant to Articles 50, 51 or 53, respectively, of the Land Use Ordinance and to the building and safety division of the department of public works, the county engineer and the district health department not less than 10 days prior to the date of such hearing.

SECTION 2. Section 110.234 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

110.234 Notice of hearing on appeals: Newspaper publication. Notice of hearings by the board of county commissioners on recommendations of the planning commission for approval of a change of land use or appeals from recommendations for approval or denial of a change of land use shall be given by the clerk of the board of county commissioners by one publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Washoe County at least 10 days before the date set for the hearing.
