AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE SILVER KNOLLS COMMUNITY PARK SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Findings.

- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of NRS chapter 271, a duly noticed hearing was held on May 14, 1985, wherein the board heard comments from citizens concerning the proposed creation of a Silver Knolls Community Park Special Improvement District.
- 2. The board finds that there were no substantial oral protests in opposition to the creation of the district and that there were no written protests filed by owners of a majority of the landowners within the proposed district.
- 3. The board finds that creation of the district would be in the best interest of Washoe County and its residents.

SECTION 2.

Creation of district, boundaries.

- 1. There is hereby created the Silver Knolls Community Park Special Improvement District.
- 2. The district will include all of the properties reflected in the attached map designated as Exhibit A and more particularly described as:

All of Sections 13, 23, 24 and 25, the East one half of the East one half (E 1/2 of the E 1/2) of Section 26, the southwest one quarter of the northeast one quarter (SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4) of the said Section 26, the East half of the northwest one quarter of the northeast one quarter (E 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4) of the said Section 26, the east one half of the east one half (E 1/2 of the E 1/2) of Section 35, the northwest one quarter of the northeast one quarter (NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4) of the said Section 35 excepting therefrom that certain property in Book 353 of Official Records, Page 615 and filed under document number 124707 on September 16, 1968 in the office of the Washoe County Recorder, Reno, Nevada, the south half (S 1/2) of Section 36

excluding the northeast one quarter of the southeast one quarter (NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4) of the said Section 36, all sections above being in T.21N, R.18E, M.D.B. & M.

SECTION 3.

Purpose. The purpose of the district is to provide funds for the maintenance of a park to be constructed at county expense on a 20-acre portion of assessor's parcel no. 087-330-10, more particularly described as T. 21 N., R. 18 E., Mt. Diablo Mer. Nv. Sec. 26: E 1/2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4.

SECTION 4.

Amount of assessment, collection, deposit.

1. Each parcel within the district will be equally assessed \$7.50 on the first general tax assessment in 1986 which will be due and payable with the first property tax installment due in July, 1986.

- 2. The money collected will be deposited in an interest bearing account which the director of the department of parks and recreation may draw upon only for the purpose of providing maintenance of the park in the event of failure of the property owners to provide such maintenance of the park as was agreed upon in sections 1 through 14 of that park services agreement dated April 9, 1985, which are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
- 3. On October 15th of each year, the director of the department of parks and recreation will report to this board concerning the status of the park and the anticipated expenses for the following park season. In the event that there are funds remaining in the account from the previous park season, the assessment for the following year will be in such amount as is needed to supplement the account to cover anticipated expenses for the following year.
- 4. Any assessments shall be paid on the first property tax assessment due in July of each year.

SECTION 5.

Distribution upon park closure. In the event the park is permanently closed, the district shall be dissolved and any funds remaining in the account will be equally distributed among the property owners within the district at the time of closure who file valid claims within 60 days of mailing of notice of dissolution of the district.
