BILL NO. 869

ORDINANCE NO. 694

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 605 BY EXTENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE THEREOF.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Findings.

1. The board finds that Ordinance No. 605, which became effective on June 25, 1984, has an expiration date of July 1, 1986, and will expire on that date unless a modified version of that ordinance is adopted before that date or unless the expiration date of that ordinance is extended.

2. The board finds that it is in the process of adopting a modified version of the massage ordinance, but that final adoption will not occur before July 1, 1986.

3. The board finds that the health, safety and welfare of the public requires that the present provisions remain in effect until such time as a new ordinance can be formally adopted.

SECTION 2. Expiration date extended. The expiration date of July 1, 1986 contained in section 20 of Ordinance 605 is hereby extended for a period of 60 days, or until a new ordinance amending Ordinance 605 is adopted and becomes effective, whichever date is earlier.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This emergency ordinance becomes effective upon passage.
