SUMMARY: Amends the Washoe County Code by permitting variations to certain minimal standards in mobile home parks and recreational vehicle parks.

ORDINANCE NO. 717

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 120 OF THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY PERMITTING VARIATIONS TO CERTAIN MINIMAL STANDARDS IN MOBILE HOME PARKS AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 120.440 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

120.440 Requirement of special use permit; compliance with laws, ordinances, regulations; variations.

1. All mobile home parks shall:

(a) Be subject to the issuance of a special use permit, following review by the county board of adjustment. Applications and procedures shall be in the manner provided by chapter 110.

(b) Comply with the provisions of chapter 25 as the same may be amended from time to time, and any and all rules and regulations which may be enacted thereunder by the recreation board with regard to the Washoe County room tax.

(c) Comply with any other applicable local, state or federal rules, regulations or statutes.

2. The county board of adjustment, as part of the special use permit procedure, may vary the requirements specified in sections 120.460 through 120.490, inclusive, in its recommendation to the board of county commissioners.

SECTION 2. Section 120.500 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

120.500 Requirement of special use permit; compliance with laws, ordinances, regulations; variations.

1. All recreational vehicle parks shall:

(a) Be subject to the issuance of a special use permit, following review by the county board of adjustment. Applications and procedures shall be in the manner provided by chapter 110.

(b) Comply with the provisions of chapter 25, as amended, and any and all rules and regulations which may be enacted thereunder by the recreation board with regard

to the Washoe County room tax.

(c) Comply with any other applicable local, state or federal rules, regulations or statutes.

2. The county board of adjustment, as part of the special use permit procedure, may vary the requirements specified in sections 120.520 through 120.540, inclusive, in its recommendation to the board of county commissioners.
