SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Code to provide that election or appointment of member of citizens advisory board to the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County results in automatic termination of person's membership on advisory board.

ORDINANCE NO. 824

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE TO PROVIDE THAT ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER OF A CITIZENS ADVISORY BOARD TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY RESULTS IN THE AUTOMATIC TERMINATION OF THAT PERSON'S MEMBERSHIP ON THE ADVISORY BOARD.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 5.429 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.429 Advisory Boards: Membership.

1. Membership. In determining the number of members on a citizens advisory board and the categories of membership, the board of county commissioners shall ensure that the advisory board consists of a representative cross-section of persons residing within the advisory board's geographical area of responsibility.

2. Appointment. When applications are needed for an advisory board, the board of county commissioners shall cause an advertisement seeking applications from interested citizens to be placed in a newspaper of general circulation in the county. Applications received in response to the advertisement shall be kept on file and remain valid for a period of 1 year from the date of receipt thereof. The board shall select a person to fill the vacancy from the applications received.

3. Officers. Citizens advisory boards shall select their own officers from among their members. Each advisory board shall have at least a chairman, a vice-chairman and a secretary-treasurer.

4. Term of office. Members of citizens advisory boards serve 2-year terms commencing on July 1 and ending June 30. When a new citizens advisory board is created, one-half of the members thereof shall be appointed for an initial 1-year term and the remaining members shall be appointed for an initial 2-year term. Although members are appointed to specific terms of office, members serve at the pleasure of

the board of county commissioners. A member may be reappointed by the board of county commissioners at the end of his term for not to exceed one additional term.

5. Vacancies. A vacancy occurring on a citizens advisory board shall be filled by the board of county commissioners for the remainder of the unexpired term. If the unexpired term is less than 1 year, the person appointed to fill the vacancy may be appointed to serve not more than two additional 2-year terms. Except as provided in subsection 7, if a member of an advisory board misses three consecutive meetings of the board without just cause as determined by the chairman of the advisory board, a vacancy in that member's position automatically occurs and the board of county commissioners shall fill the vacancy as set forth in this subsection.

6. Alternates. A member may designate an alternate with the same membership qualifications as the member to be his representative at any citizens advisory board meeting. No designation is effective until the person selected as an alternate is approved by the board of county commissioners. In the regular member's absence, an alternate has the same authority to act on the advisory board as the regular member, but may not act as an officer of the advisory board. Except as provided in subsection 7, an alternate may not act at more than two consecutive meetings.

7. Elective public office. A member of a citizens advisory board must take a leave of absence from the board during any period of time in which he is a candidate or applicant for appointment to the Board of County Commissioners. A leave of absence does not constitute absence without cause as a member of the board and the alternate designated by that member may act in his place and stead until the member is no longer a candidate. Election or appointment of a member to the board of county commissioners will result in automatic termination of that person's membership on the advisory board.
