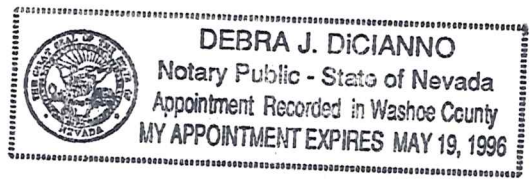

SUMMARY:Amends Washoe County Code provisions relating to reports of occupationally related injury and illness.

BILL NO. 1038

ORDINANCE NO. 863

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY REQUIRING ADDITIONAL REPORTS OF OCCUPATIONALLY RELATED INJURY AND ILLNESS, BY REDUCING THE TIME FOR MAKING SUCH REPORTS, AND BY ADDING TO THE LIST OF INJURIES AND ILLNESSES WHICH MUST BE REPORTED.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 65.180 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

65.180 Written reports required for occupationally related injury, illness. A "Washoe County Employer's Report of Industrial Injury or Occupational Disease" and a "Supervisor's Report of Injury" shall be submitted to the county safety officer when any occupationally related injury or illness results in:

1. Death, regardless of the time between the injury and death or the length of the illness.
2. Absence from work.
3. Necessity for transfer to another job or termination of employment.
4. Loss of consciousness.
5. Restriction of work or movement.
6. Medical treatment of any kind, including first aid.
7. A situation where an employee thinks he may have been injured regardless of the severity of the injury.

SECTION 1. Section 65.200 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

65.200 Injury or illness report forms; time period for submittal. Appropriate forms shall be completed and distributed as directed for each occupational injury or illness described in section 65.180. Reports shall be prepared and submitted as soon as possible, but not later than 3 days after the injury or illness.
